

# BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN NURSING



## JOB DESCRIPTION

The nurse is an essential link in the patients' care. He or she contributes to the treatment by identifying the needs of the person, posing a nursing diagnosis, formulating healthcare goals, implementing the appropriate actions and evaluating them.



### Possible work places

In France, nurses can work in different types of sectors (private, public, association, humanitarian) and structures (hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, schools, companies, etc.). They can also work as a visiting nurse, in home care.



### Professional evolution perspectives

The Nursing National Diploma being equivalent to an undergraduate degree, nurses can continue their studies in the BMD system (Bachelor's Master's Doctorate). By doing so, they can specialize and assume new functions in operating room, anesthesia, childcare, etc. They can also become healthcare manager to occupy higher functions in the hierarchy.

- Be 17 years old at the beginning of the course,

# CONTENT OF THE COURSE



## The theoretical teaching covers 10 key skills

- Evaluate a clinical situation and establish a diagnosis in the nursing field,
- Design and lead a nursing project,
- Accompany patients in the realization of their care,
- Implement actions for diagnosis and therapeutic purposes,
- Initiate and implement educational and preventive care,
- Communicate and lead a relationship in a healthcare context,
- Analyze the quality of care and improve one's professional practice,
- Research, process and analyze professional and scientific data,
- Organize and coordinate care interventions,
- Inform and train professionals and interns.



## 3 years (6 semesters) of course

- 2 100 hours of theoretical classes
- 2 100 hours of work placement



## Teaching methods and resources

The teaching team is composed of permanent teachers, external speakers, and experts in the various fields of the course. Teaching is done in the form of lectures, practical courses, tutorials, personal work and work placements. We offer online training modules and simulated situations in laboratories.
