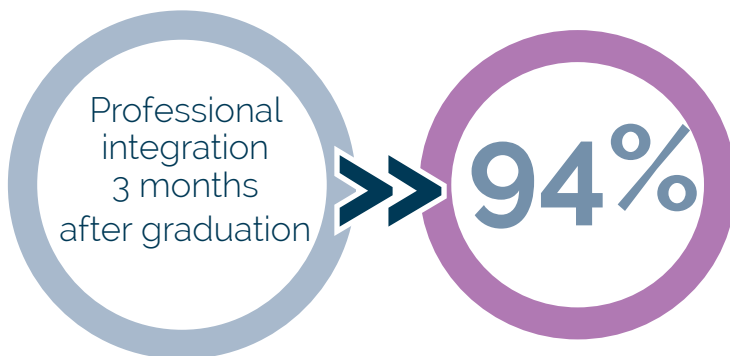
Possible work places

In France, assistant nurses can work in the hospital sector (public hospitals or private clinics) or in other healthcare structures such as nursing homes, centers for people with disabilities, or even in home care

The assistant nurse diploma offers opportunities for evolution towards other healthcare and social professions, such as nurse, childcare assistant, educational and social assistant or paramedic.

- Be 17 years old at the beginning of the course
- No diploma condition

CONTENT OF THE COURSE



The theoretical teaching covers 8 modules

- M1 - Accompanying people in their daily life activities,
- M2 - The clinical state of a person,
- M3 - Healthcare,
- M4 - Ergonomics,
- M5 - Relationship - Communication,
- M6 - Hygiene of the premises,
- M7 - Transmission of information,
- M8 - Work organization.



1 year (41 weeks) of course

- 595 hours of theoretical classes
- 840 hours of work placement



Teaching methods and resources

The teaching team is composed of permanent teachers, external speakers, and experts in the various fields of the course. Teaching is done in the form of analyses of professional practice, group tutorials, practical work, participation in punctual or regular field actions, supervision of the student's course project and professional project through a personalized educational follow-up.
